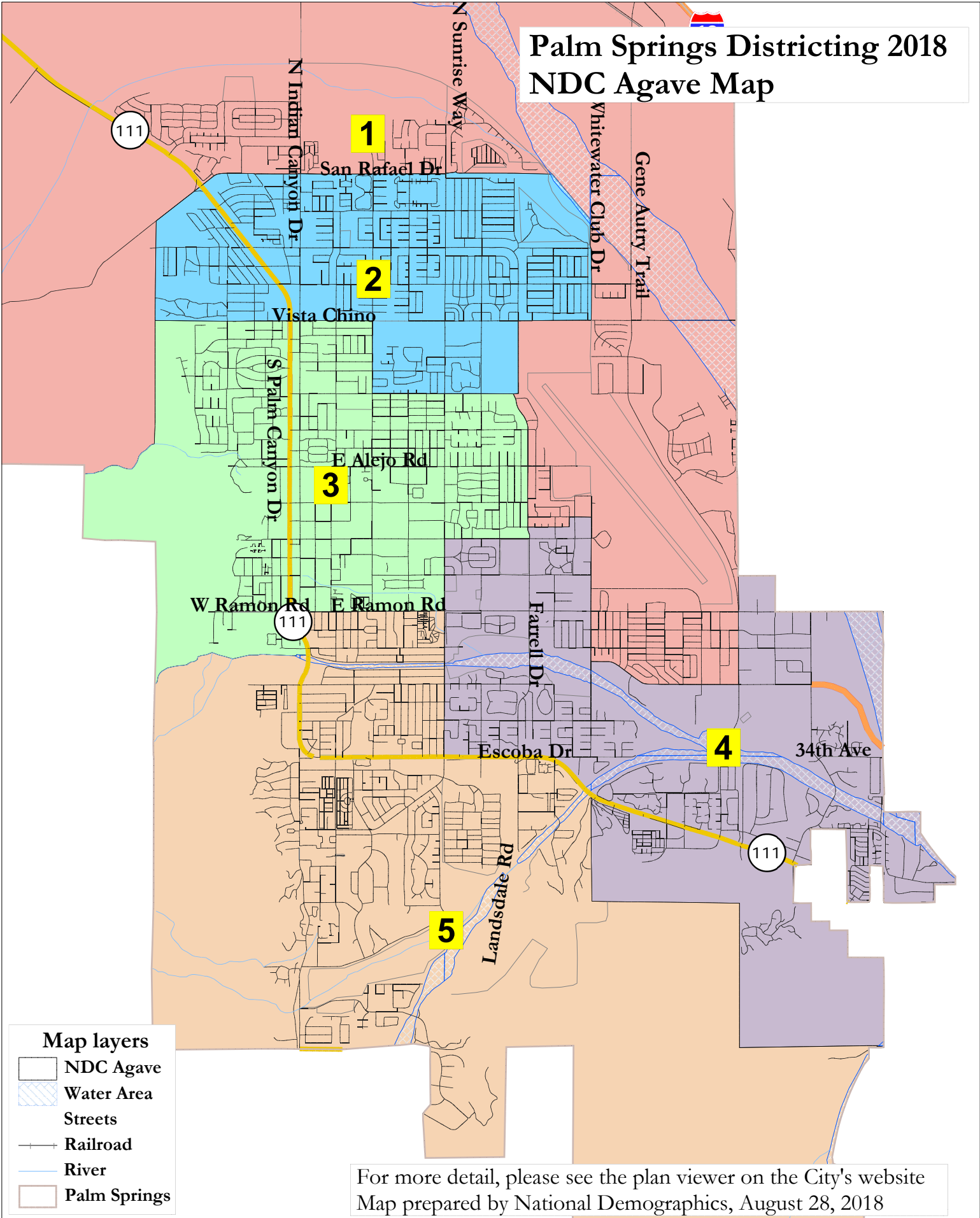








# Palm Springs Districting 2018 NDC Agave Map
