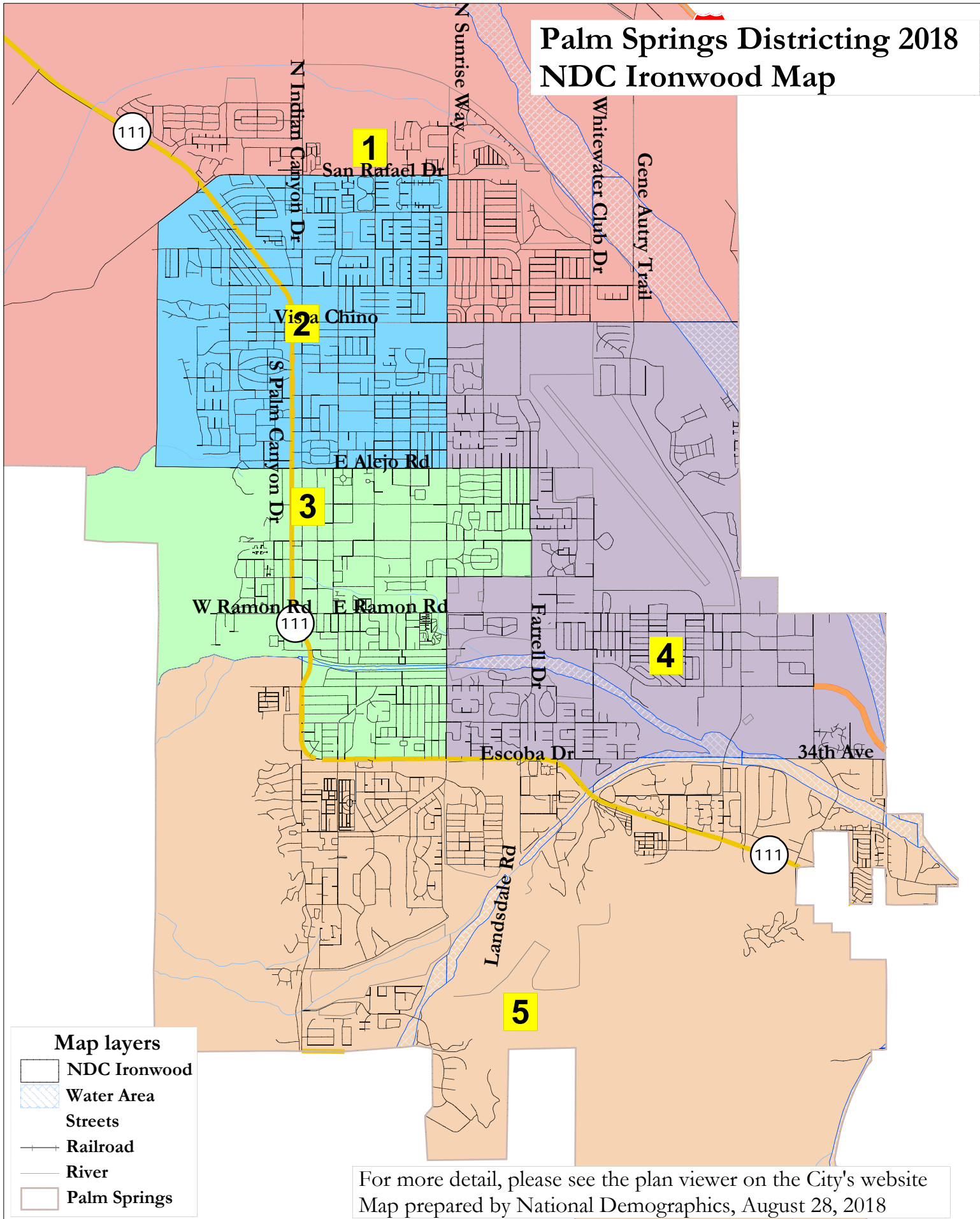








# Palm Springs Districting 2018 NDC Ironwood Map
