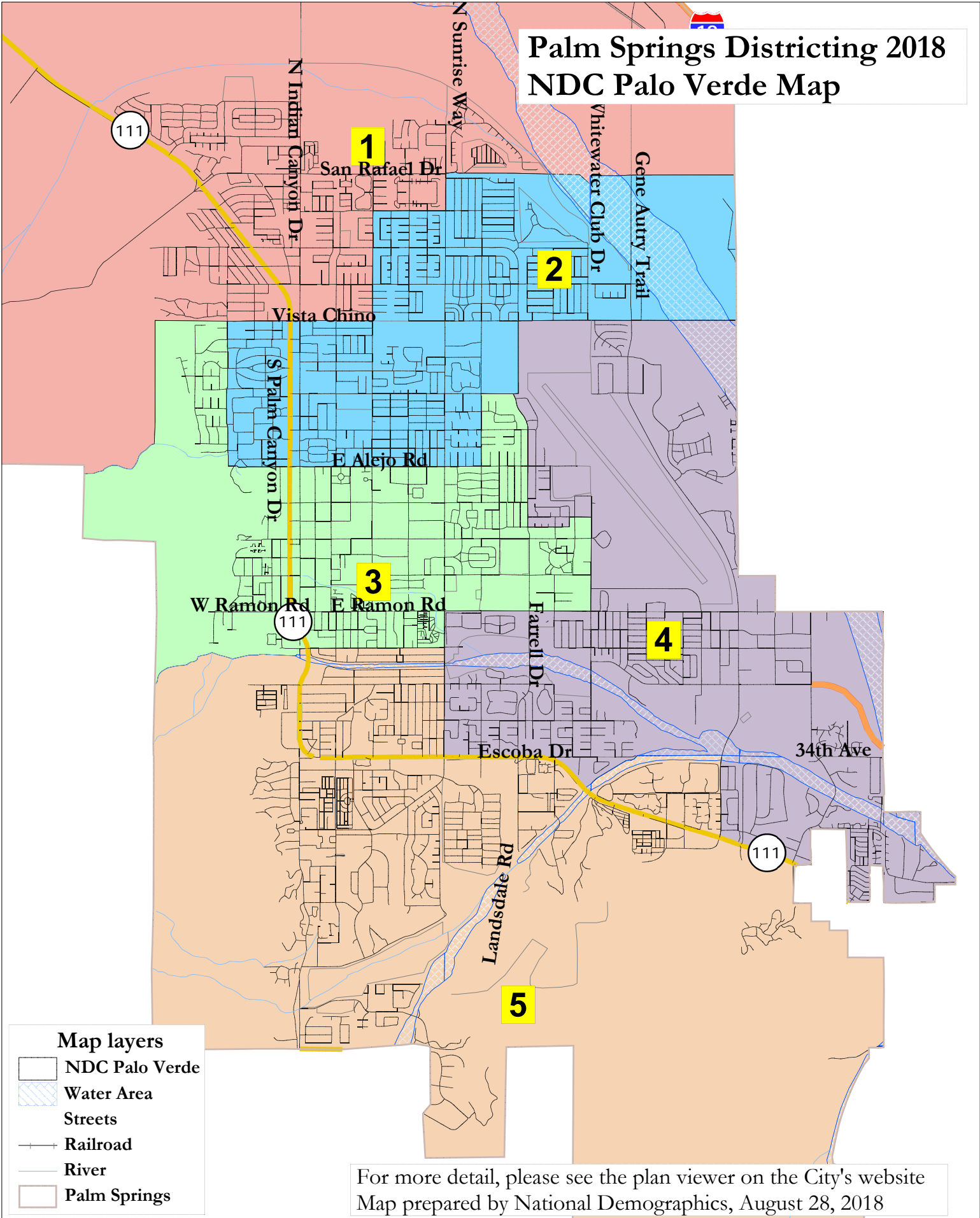








# Palm Springs Districting 2018 NDC Palo Verde Map
