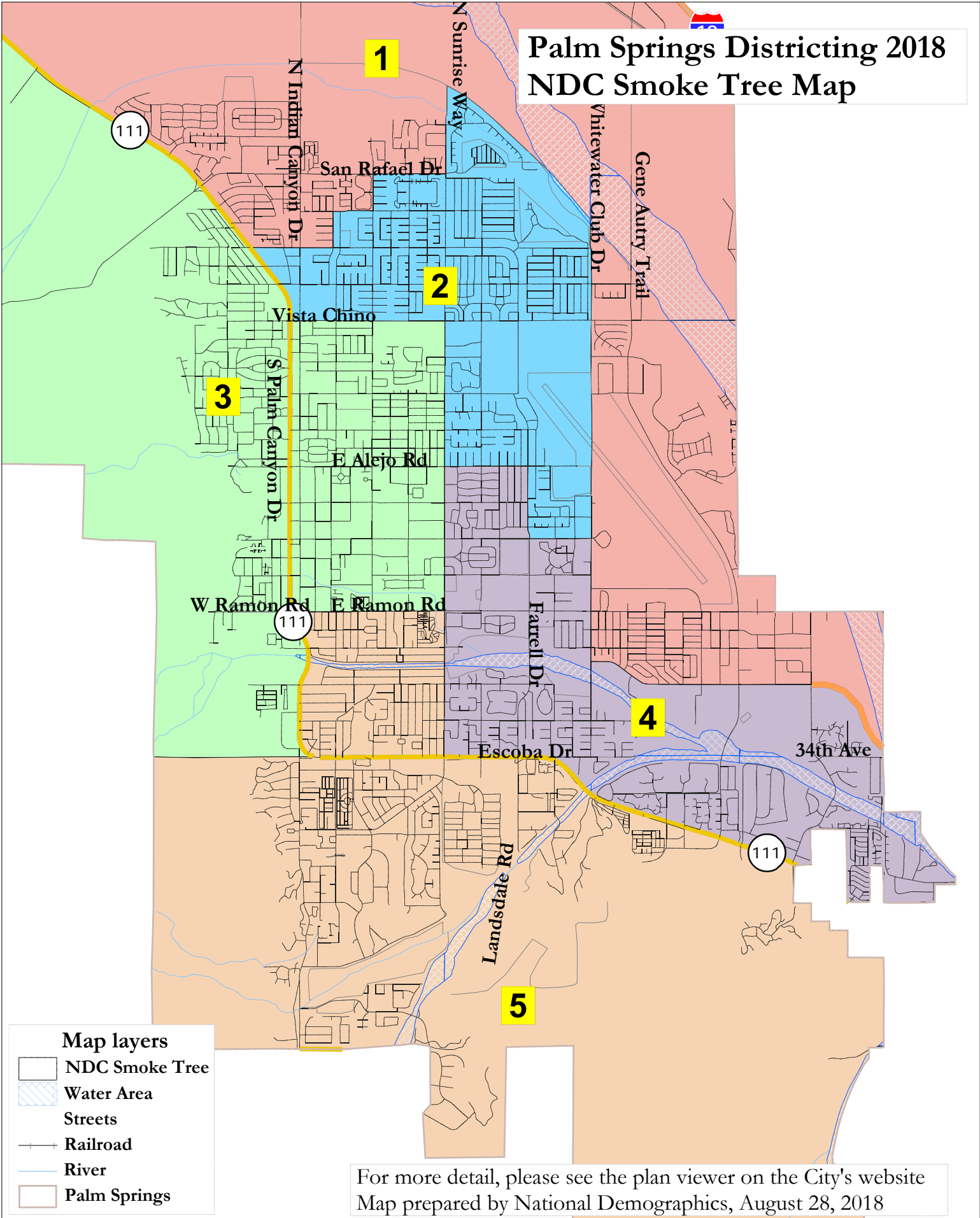


# Palm Springs Districting 2018 NDC Smoke Tree Map
