

The City Clerk's Office conducted an analysis of voter drop-off for the cities of Cathedral City and Indio during the November 2018 Statewide General Election and those cities' by-district municipal election. The City of Cathedral City saw an average of 12.34% and the City of Indio saw an average of 7.19% in voter drop-off, for an overall average of 9.76% voter drop-off (**Attachment 3**).

The following are potential options to modify General Municipal Elections to substantially comply with the provisions of SB-415:

Option 1 - Extend terms for one (1) year.
